Course fees and Payment

All fees must be paid in full or finalised by assessment day.

Heavy Industry Training accepts payment by Visa and Mastercard - no surcharge. (Excluding American Express).

For your convenience Heavy Industry Training accepts EFTPOS payments and If you rather pay in person, our friendly staff will assist you on the day you attend. Cash Payments are also accepted.

We do require a minimum of \$500 deposit once you proceed with enrolment. The deposit will secure and reserve a spot for your attendance. You will also receive all the necessary training materials, and items (depending on the course you are enrolling for).

We appreciate your understanding that a \$500 deposit might be a substantial amount to some, but it is necessary to cover your assessment fees which is a certain amount off the overall course fee paid by us on your behalf to an Accredited WorkSafe NSW Assessor, who will ultimately assess you and your knowledge on assessment day.



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Cancellations and Refund Policy

All cancellations and refund requests must be made in writing to Heavy Industry Training 7 days prior to course commencement date.

In the event of a cancellation, Heavy Industry Training will refund the amount paid in full, only if we are advised in writing of the cancellation minimum 7 days prior to course commencement date.

Heavy Industry Training will not issue any refunds if the requests were made in short notice or less than the specified 7-day timeframe.

Heavy Industry Training will not issue any refunds for non-attendance.

If a candidate is unable to attend the course, nominated individuals are allowed to attend on their behalf as a substitute - free of charge.

If requesting to transfer or re-locate to different courses. Heavy Industry Training must be advised prior to course commencement date and can be arranged depending on availabilities of courses.

Should the scheduled course not proceed due to either, low student numbers or any unforeseen reasons, the candidates will be advised immediately and either postpone the course to a later date, or a full refund will be issued.

Training overview

Our organization and trainer/assessor have created training programs, documents have been created of the training assessment. The Verification of Competency (VOC) we have developed a training gap analysis based of the assessment report. Based on our findings with our staff and clients, we can create an appropriate training program developed as per the client's request. Once the program has been created, we can create a training schedule and a training outline for your employees.

Enrolment

Upon enrolment, you will receive a confirmation e-mail to the same e-mail address you provided. This process is automated which means you will receive the e-mail right away - please allow up to a few minutes in the event of a delay.

The confirmation will outline all the course details and all necessary requirements for you to follow. Please do not ignore the e-mail as it contains all the information and instructions such as:

- Course commencement date
- Duration of the course
- Starting and finishing times
- PPE Requirements
- Course fees
- USI Number - How to create a USI number, or instructions on how to obtain a forgotten one

Heavy Industry Training courses are specifically designed for the construction industry.

To be eligible to enrol in our training program, participant must be:

- over 18 years of age
- satisfactorily complete our English assessment
- able to provide photo identification
- physically fit and not have any physical conditions that would preclude holding a driver's licence.



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All units of competency delivered by us are nationally recognised and can only be delivered by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that complies with the governing standards of quality control and quality training and assessment.

Assessment is based on competency i.e. ability to perform tasks to a required standard. Assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, class discussions, verbal questioning and written testing.

The outcome of this training program will be:

- Statement of Attainment for a relevant Unit of competency
- Nationally recognised interim certificate,
- Certificate of Competency will be issued by the Regulator within the 60 day period upon submitting valid application.

Course

Most of our training programs are delivered over five (5) consecutive days, consisting of 4 days training and 1 day's assessment at Heavy Industry Training's premises, other employer premises or live work site. See individual course description pages for details on each course.

The 9 hour long days consist of 8 hours training, 2 x 15 min tea breaks and a 30 minute lunch break and while training normally starts at 7:00 am, start and meal times are flexible. Afternoon/Night course are available these start and meal times are flexible and assessments can be completed on weekend.

Participants should plan to spend up to 2 hours per night reviewing their handouts, reviewing their learning materials and if need arises, have a note ready to contact the trainer/assessor who will be able to provide assistance on addressing any learning needs and clarifications.

Maximum class size is 6 people.

While we can support you with some English language skills, should your needs for support or assistance exceed our skills, we will refer you to a suitable organisation to assist you further, this may be TAFE local to you.

Training Schedules
